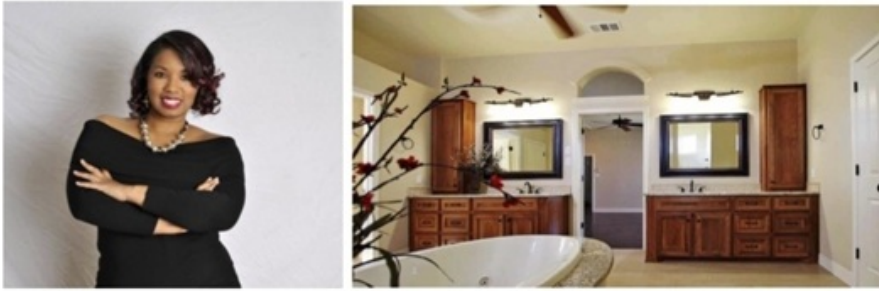

as Lauren

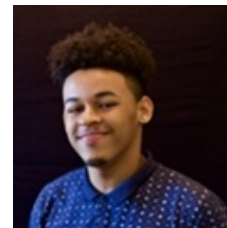

as Aunt Pearl

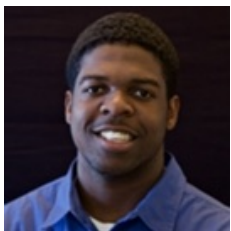
